Feast Day of St. Anne and St. Joachim Pilgrimage Walk: On Friday, July 27, St. Anne's Parish will celebrate the feast day of Our Blessed Virgin Mary's parents and invites all pilgrims to celebrate Holy Mass at 10:30am following a pilgrimage walk to the church. Light refreshments will be provided after Mass. The Pilgrimage walk starts at Stella Maris Parish Church and proceeds via back roads to St Anne's church. You may choose a long walk or a shorter walk.
