Question of the Week: Is there purgatory, if it is there why it is not mentioned in the bible? Answer: The Catholic Church holds that "all who die in God's grace and friendship but still imperfectly purified" undergo this process (which the Church calls purgatory), "so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven". It has formulated this doctrine by reference to biblical verses that speak of purifying fire (1 Corinthians 3:15 and 1 Peter 1:7) and to the mention by Jesus of forgiveness in the age to come (Matthew 12:32). It bases its teaching also on the practice of praying for the dead in use within the Church ever since the Church began and which is mentioned even earlier in 2 Macc 12:46.

Lenten Mission and Reconciliation service will be held on Wednesday, April 10 at St. Anne's at 7pm. The main preacher will be Fr. Brandon Gallant.
