Feast Day of St. Anne and St. Joachim Pilgrimage Walk: On Friday, July 26, St Anne's Parish will celebrate the Feast Day of Our Blessed Virgin Mary's parents and invites all pilgrims to celebrate Holy Mass at 10:30 am following a pilgrimage walk to the church. Knights of Columbus members will lead walks, provide walking maps, drinking water, road crossing safety and return transportation to parked cars following the Mass. Walkers are reminded to wear sensible walking footwear and to apply sun protection if needed. Rain will cancel walks only.
