Elevator Update: Now that our elevator to the parish hall is fully functional & has been used by many individuals who would otherwise have not been able to attend parish functions, the Property & Finance Committee feel we should provide parishioners a summary of how this much needed addition to our church was made possible financially. The following is a breakdown of the \$37,117 in funds received: Local businesses and organizations - \$9,250, Parishioners - \$11,450. New Horizons Program -\$16,417. Over & above these donations, it is estimated that there was an equivalent to approximately \$15,000 in volunteer and donated work. The total cost of the elevator including making one bathroom wheelchair accessible was \$35.061. This left a balance in the elevator account of \$2,055 for future licensing & maintenance.
