Question: What is the proper way to receive Communion? Answer: We should do a simple bow before receiving. Our left hand holds our right hand into which Jesus is placed. When the words "the body of Christ" are spoken we should answer "Amen", then use our right hand to place the host into our mouth. We chew the host saying a thank you prayer of our choice, such as "thank you Jesus for coming to me in this blessed sacrament".

Question: What is the proper way to give the sign of peace. **Answer:** A gesture such as a nod, a handshake or a hand wave is meant to offer "the Peace of Christ" to one another. Eye contact is a part of the sign. A handshake should be firm, not limp.
