

is carried in the Entrance Procession of the Mass. If a deacon is not present, the reader carries the elevated Book. The Book of Gospels' presence in the Entrance Procession is an older practice than carrying the cross. Like the cross, it signifies the presence of Christ, followed not only by liturgical ministers in church, but by all of us in our lives. When the reader arrives in the sanctuary, the Book of Gospels is placed—closed—on the altar until the time when it is carried to the ambo by the priest or deacon. Its place at both altar and ambo reminds us that the same Christ nourishes us with his saving presence in Sacrament and in Word.
