The absence of the Book of Gospels from the Recessional Procession reminds us that it is not a book that carries the Gospel from the church into the week ahead. Together, we-the assembly of believers—are the means through whom the Good News of Jesus Christ is borne into the world. How wonderful for us to be reminded of that when we are sent forth with the commission, "Go, and proclaim the Gospel of the Lord," and we accept the mandate with our response, "Thanks be to God!"
