Development and Peace-CARITAS Canada's theme this fourth Sunday of Lent is Human Rights. As Jesus was stripped of his garments, large foreign corporations have stripped indigenous partners in Africa, Asia and Latin America of their rights to ancestral lands and their right to grow food, build shelter and drink clean water. Our donations on Solidarity Sunday, March 21, help them to regain those rights.

A Silver Rose on a nine-month pilgrimage will be the centerpiece of a special prayer service at eight churches on Prince Edward Island starting on March 18. This program is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus councils in these localities to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe and express both international unity and dedication to the sanctity of human life. The Rose will end its pilgrimage at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe near Mexico City on December 12, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. All members of the community are invited to attend.
