Sisters of St. Martha Centennial Award, funded by the St. Dunstan's University (SDU) Board of Governors, was established in 2016 in honour of the 100th Anniversary of the foundation of the Sisters of St. Martha. The scholarship also recognizes the contribution the Sisters made to SDU. It will be awarded annually to a third or fourth year Prince Edward Island female student in a post-secondary institution who is pursuing studies in the field of ecology, ethics, theology, education, healthcare or social work areas. The scholarship is valued at \$2,016 per year and is non-renewable. Application deadline is May 15.

Pilgrimage Walk Across PEI May 19-27 - Join Fr. Albin Arsenault and Jimmy Arsenault, two Cursillistas, as they embark on a 9-day pilgrimage walk across PEI beginning in Tignish on May 19. They will be walking the 273 km with an open invitation to anyone who would like to join them along the way. This fundraiser for a new roof for Immaculate Conception Church in Palmer Road is "more than a walk." Cursillistas are called to fully live the "fourth day" as Christ our Lord rose on the third day.
