Indigenous Reconciliation Campaign Fund –The Catholic Bishops of Canada (CCCB) announced that they were committed to raising thirty-million-dollars over a five-year period (2022 – 2027). This major fund-raising effort will be known as the Indigenous Reconciliation Campaign Fund. Each diocese of Canada is expected to participate. Our diocese will designate a Sunday in early November (over the next five years), as the Sunday when a collection will be taken up throughout the diocese. This will give the people of our diocese the opportunity to contribute to this worthy cause. All monies raised will go to a central fund managed by the CCCB. Envelopes will be distributed in the weeks leading up to the collection and will be part of the yearly envelopes going forward.
