An Invitation to all ladies of St. John Paul II Pastoral Unit: The St. John Paul II Ladies Group was established two years ago, after ending our association with the Catholic Women's League. It has been a great success, often with over 30 women attending. There are no membership fees or lists; all ladies of all three parishes are automatically members and most welcome. We do continue with most of the activities of our previous CWL group, donating to our various charities, from funds raised by our annual card party and the proceeds of the 50/50 draw at the Knights of Columbus suppers, for which we make the desserts. Meetings are held every second month, and begin with a lunch at noon, prepared by the ladies of one of the parishes, alternating this duty. Following this, we have a spiritual presentation, sometimes by a member, or sometimes by a guest speaker from some community service organization. Last fall, we had a speaker from Anderson House, a shelter for women and children fleeing family violence. In support, the ladies brought donations of toiletries, which were much needed and appreciated. A main focus of our group is outreach, and especially at Christmas, members reach out to seniors, shut-ins and nursing home residents in our individual communities. Members of our Community Outreach Committee send cards throughout the year to acknowledge special as well as sorrowful occasions in the lives of members of our communities. Members of our Social Justice Committee keep us informed on issues of interest to Christians committed to caring for all members of our society. Meetings end with a round table of prayer intentions, when members ask for prayers for a particular or a more general intention. We invite all ladies to join us, you are most welcome. Our next meeting is April 9.
