St. André Bessette Relics Coming to St. Augustine's: Tuesday July 9, 6pm. St. André Bessette, though lacking formal education and facing his own health struggles, dedicated himself to serving God. As doorkeeper at Notre Dame College, his welcoming presence extended not just to people, but to God's love and healing grace. Many who sought him out with prayers experienced restoration in body and spirit. His reputation as a holy intercessor grew, attracting countless pilgrims to the Oratory of Saint Joseph. There, St. André tirelessly received the sick and suffering, becoming known as the "Miracle Man of Montreal." Though the Church ultimately determines the validity of miracles, the numerous crutches and braces left behind by the healed stand as a testament to the power of faith and St. André's intercession before God. His life reminds us that even in ordinary service, profound holiness and God's healing touch can be found.
